We have a new system for keeping the little pantry stocked. There is a sign-up sheet on the short hall bulletin board where you can sign up to tend to the pantry for a week at a time. It involves bringing items from the counting room out to the pantry twice during your assigned week.

The Little Pantry in front of the Church is used often and, therefore, frequently empty. Please help by putting items directly in the pantry. Thank you. This week's suggestions: coffee, creamer, and sugar.
